LOCATION OF THE ROYAL COLLEGE OF SURGEONS OF ENGLAND

The College is centrally located at Lincoln's Inn Fields within easy walking distance of Holborn (Piccadilly and Central lines) and Temple (District and Circle Lines) underground stations. It is a short taxi or underground journey from most major rail stations. Two NCP car parks are situated nearby at Drury Lane and Bloomsbury Square.

By Underground The nearest Tube station is Holborn (Piccadilly and Central Lines). It takes about 10 minutes to walk from the station to the college.

By Rail The nearest stations are Kings Cross St. Pancras, Euston, Waterloo and Charing Cross. It takes about 20-30 minutes to walk from each to the College.

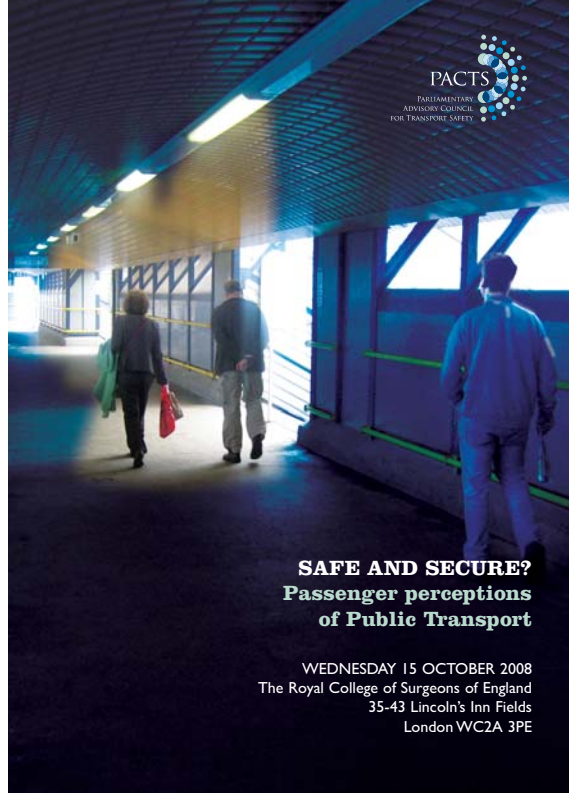

Safe and Secure?

Statistically, it is clearly safer to travel by public transport. Deaths per trip, per hour of exposure, or per journey length are all lower when the mode of travel is by bus, coach or rail.

However, not all users recognise the truth of the statistics. Furthermore, many potential users are put off from travel by public transport because of a perception that such modes offer less protection for their personal security. An unstaffed railway station at night, a train that appears to have no conductor, an unlit path to the station car park are all disincentives to using public transport.

In recent years, there has been much analysis of what prevents people from using public transport and how we might overcome these barriers. It is important to consider this research especially in the context of climate change where we want people to look at more environmentally friendly travel modes.

This conference will be an opportunity to hear from researchers, practitioners and users on the challenges facing transport in merging issues of safety and security. It will look at the risks posed across the whole journey for rail and bus users, and the potential conflicts between different groups of users and at practical interventions to make journeys safer.
