

Travelling by taxi during Covid-19

21 November 2020



Almost nine in ten of those who have used a taxi in the last four weeks felt safe doing so. Just less than half of those who have not used a taxi say that they would feel safe to do so.

12% have used a taxi* in the last four weeks



More than half say that the driver wearing a mask would be most important to them when considering travelling by taxi



Survey method and sample breakdown

- c.2000 online interviews using Yonder Consulting weekly omnibus.
- Nationally representative of Great British population.
- Fieldwork carried out 6 8 November
