



# Travelling by taxi during Covid-19

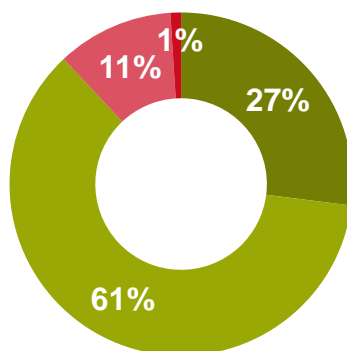

**Almost nine in ten of those who have used a taxi in the last four weeks felt safe doing so. Just less than half of those who have not used a taxi say that they would feel safe to do so.**

**12% have used a taxi\* in the last four weeks**

**Specifically in relation to coronavirus, how safe do you feel at the moment when using taxis\*?**

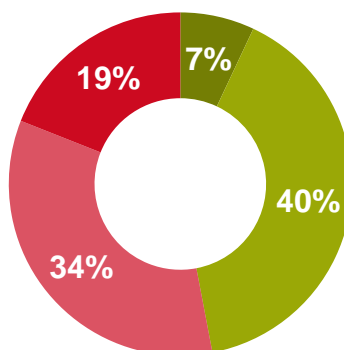

Base: All *who have not* made a journey by taxi in the last four weeks – 1,738



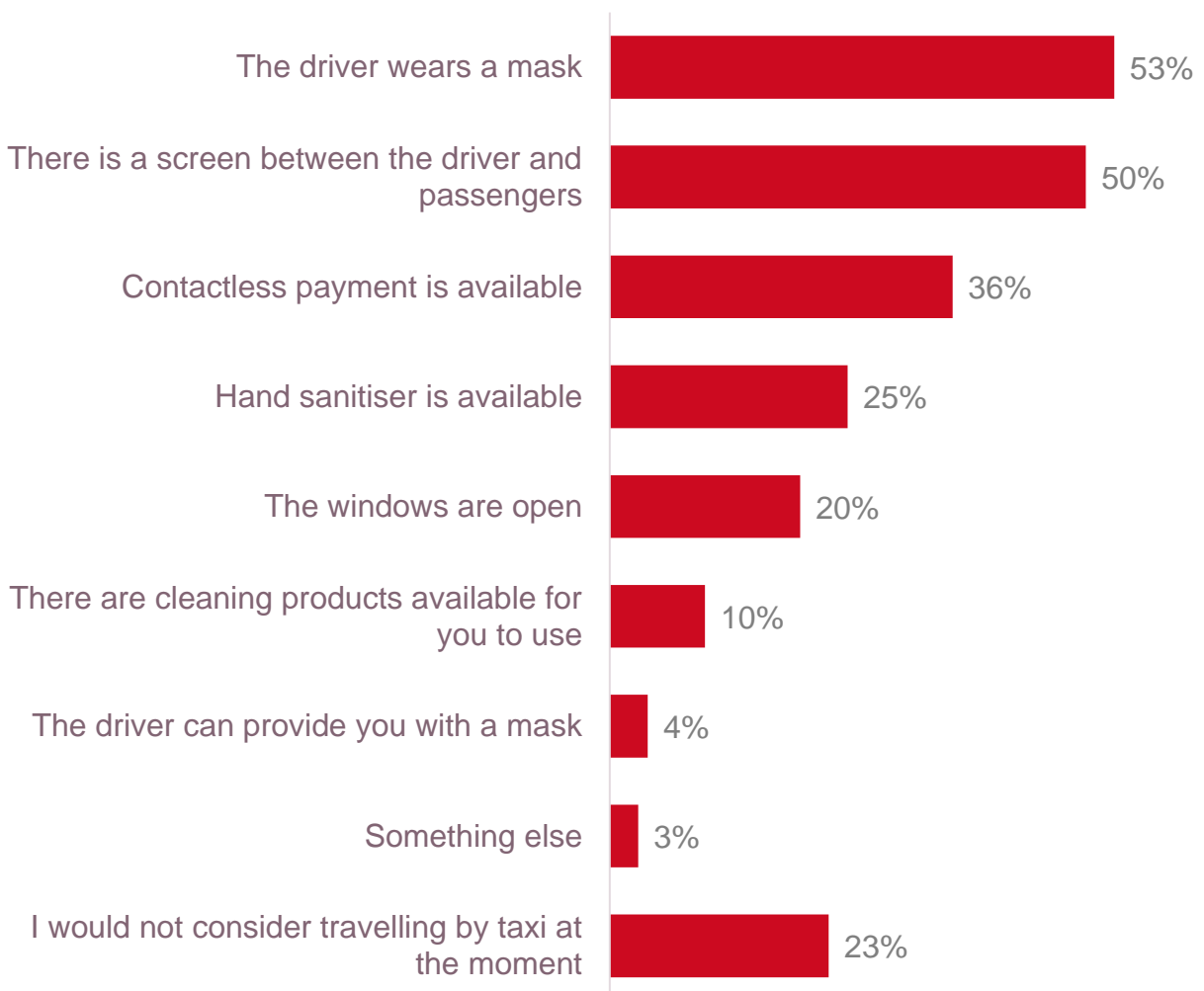
■ Very Safe ■ Fairly safe ■ Not very safe ■ Not at all safe

- c.2000 online interviews using Yonder Consulting weekly omnibus.
- Nationally representative of Great British population.
- Fieldwork carried out 6 – 8 November
