






Travel during Covid-19: omnibus week 31 The proportion of people using public transport has fallen in recent weeks




Travel during Covid-19: omnibus week 31 Small proportions have used trains and buses




Travel during Covid-19: omnibus week 31 Road use has increased slowly over time but has fallen recently



Travel during Covid-19: omnibus week 31 Falling proportions have made journeys on foot or by bike




Travel during Covid-19: omnibus week 31 Falling proportions have made journeys to take exercise


Travel during Covid-19: omnibus week 31 The proportion of those avoiding using public transport, or not feeling safe doing so, has generally fallen over time, but has risen recently

Specifically in relation to coronavirus, how safe do you feel at the moment when using trains? Base: All making journeys by train, W31 – 58






Almost four in five of those making bus journeys in the last seven days felt safe doing so

Specifically in relation to coronavirus, how safe do you feel at the moment when using buses? Base: All making journeys by bus, W31 – 178




Almost half of those who have not used a train in the last seven days would feel safe doing so



Survey method and sample breakdown – week 31

- c.2000 online interviews per week. Using Yonder Consulting weekly omnibus.
- Nationally representative of Great British population not all respondents are passengers on public transport.
- Those who have provided a response are excluded from the subsequent wave of research.
- Fieldwork repeated each weekend. Week 31 fieldwork: 27–29 November
- The analysis of attitudinal questions excludes responses from those who don't have an opinion or who say that the question is not applicable to them
