






## The proportion of people using public transport has risen in recent weeks







# Travel during Covid-19: omnibus week 33 Small proportions have used trains and buses



# Travel during Covid-19: omnibus week 33 Road use is relatively consistent




Two in five have made journeys on foot, while fewer have made journeys by bike






Rising proportions have made journeys to visit friends and relatives or for leisure reasons over recent weeks

A quarter have not used public transport in the last seven days because they do not feel safe doing so. A similar proportion have been avoiding doing so.





Base: All making journeys by train, W33 – 101




# Four in five of those making bus journeys in the last seven days felt safe doing so

% Not very / Not at all safe


Very / Fairly safe





I think that public transport is cleaner now than it was before the pandemic




# Seven in ten say that they are avoiding doing things they feel are unnecessary because they are worried about Covid-19



Three in five of those who used public transport regularly before March this year agree that they will use public transport as much, or more than they did previously when enough people have been vaccinated

When enough people have been vaccinated against COVID-19 then I expect to use public transport as much, or more than I did before March this year.



# Survey method and sample breakdown – week 33

- c.2000 online interviews per week. Using Yonder Consulting weekly omnibus.
- Nationally representative of Great British population not all respondents are passengers on public transport.
- Those who have provided a response are excluded from the subsequent wave of research.
- Fieldwork repeated each weekend. Week 33 fieldwork: 11-13 December
- The analysis of attitudinal questions excludes responses from those who don't have an opinion or who say that the question is not applicable to them
