








Travel during Covid-19: omnibus wave 38 The proportion of people using public transport has remained consistent recently






Travel during Covid-19: omnibus wave 38 Small proportions have used trains and buses




Travel during Covid-19: omnibus wave 38 Road use has increased recently


Two in five have made journeys on foot, while fewer have made journeys by bike




falling proportions have not used public transport in the last two weeks because they have been avoiding doing so.




More than four in five of those making train journeys in the last two weeks felt safe doing so




More than four in five of those making bus journeys in the last two weeks felt safe doing so








More than a third of those who have not used a bus in the last two weeks would feel safe doing so

Base: All excluding those making journeys by bus, W38 – 1,836




Transport Focus Data Hub

Survey method and sample breakdown – week 38

- c.2000 online interviews per wave. Using Yonder Consulting omnibus.
- Nationally representative of Great British population not all respondents are passengers on public transport.
- Those who have provided a response are excluded from the subsequent wave of research.
- Fieldwork repeated on every other weekend. Wave 38 fieldwork: 5-7
 March
- The analysis of attitudinal questions excludes responses from those who don't have an opinion or who say that the question is not applicable to them
