


A quarter have used public transport in the last seven days






Use of train generally and bus use in London has decreased compared with last week

Three in five of those who are working have travelled to work and have not worked from home over the last seven days




Nine in ten of those making journeys by bus outside London in the last seven days say that they felt safe doing so






More than four in five of those making journeys by bus in London in the last seven days say that they felt safe doing so


On your most recent bus journey did you wear a face covering? Base: All making journeys by bus (365)

There has been a sharp decline in the proportion wearing face coverings on train or bus journeys



Among those using trains in England (excluding London) less than a half wore a face covering on their last train journey, while three in five did so when using a bus












Two thirds say that they feel safer using public transport with people wearing face coverings

For around two in five Coronavirus is a major concern. Those who have a disability are more likely than others to agree.




More than a quarter do not feel that enough is being done to ensure coronavirus safety on public transport


Less than two in five say that they will never again feel completely comfortable on public transport



Survey method and sample breakdown – week 81

- c.2000 online interviews per wave. Using Yonder Consulting omnibus.
- Nationally representative of Great British population not all respondents are passengers on public transport.
- Those who have provided a response are excluded from the subsequent wave of research.
- Fieldwork repeated every weekend. Wave 81 fieldwork: 4-6 March 2022
- The analysis of attitudinal questions excludes responses from those who don't have an opinion or who say that the question is not applicable to them.
